

# Home learning ideas for History

Create a fact book about different periods of history. You can include some really silly or disgusting facts.

Can you create a family tree? How many generations can you go back? How many members of your family do you know now? Has anything surprised you about your family?

Watch an episode of Horrible Histories on YouTube. Can you research what has been portrayed with accuracy?

Can you create a family quiz about something in history. You could create different rounds like a picture round and a famous quotes. Then play with your family.

Can you complete a PowerPoint about something that interests you in history.

Look at the history of your local town, village, city. What is your local area famous for? Are there any significant individuals from your local area?

Compare and contrast how your local area has changed over time. Can you create a poster or collage to show the changes?

Can you complete a fact file of a significant individual?

Choose a event in history and then either write a newspaper article about it or imagine your someone living there and write a diary entry. Use your 5 senses to help you create a really descriptive piece.

Can you use the recycling from your home to create a model from history. Can you paint it, colour it, design it using any form of colour you wish.

Can you create a 'time capsule' with some of today's popular items, draw a picture of yourself now, find newspaper clippings of what's currently happening and write a letter explaining what your life is like right now. — what is favourite colour, who are your friends, what job do you want to do in the future? - Then bury the capsule in your garden so that you or someone else can look back at it and find out what was life was like today.
